### **Physical Education Teacher**

This person will implement and maintain the school's comprehensive pre-kindergarten through grade eight program. A qualified candidate will possess a passion for teaching and promote a physically active, healthy lifestyle in elementary and middle school students' lives. They will be an enthusiastic, dynamic, and vibrant member of the community who upholds the school's values and shares a dedication to educating the whole child. This is a full-time, exempt, and benefit-eligible position. It is a ten-month position and reports to the director of athletics. This position is not eligible for employer-sponsored relocation.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Co-teach physical education classes in pre-kindergarten to grade five.
- Coach all three seasons of middle school athletics for grades six to eight.
- Collaborate to design and implement a comprehensive pre-kindergarten to grade eight curriculum.
- Commit to fostering a diverse and inclusive community in and out of the classroom.
- Demonstrate instructional excellence by knowing students, adapting curriculum, and keeping careful anecdotal records to write thoughtful reports.
- Remain current with best practices for the developmental needs of children and adolescents, and take advantage of professional development opportunities.
- Embrace the school's six core values and become a contributing member of the community through various schoolwide duties and responsibilities.
